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Theatrical performance to promote the Human Brotherhood



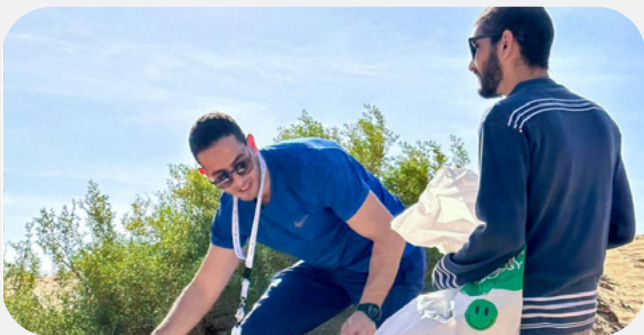

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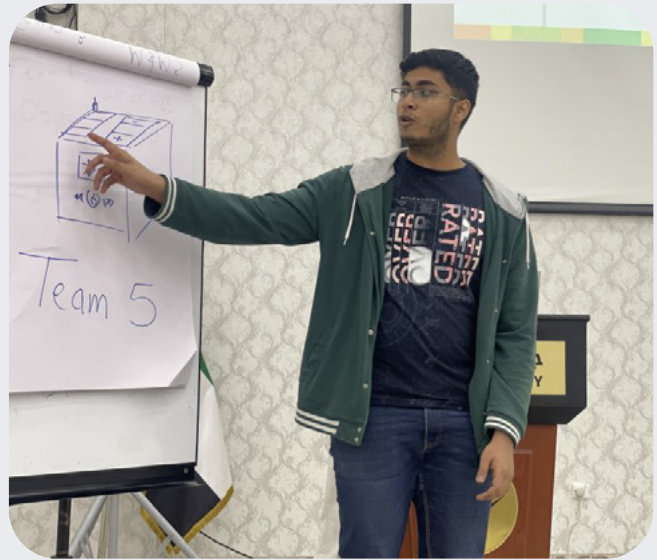


AAU organizes ICAMP Workshop

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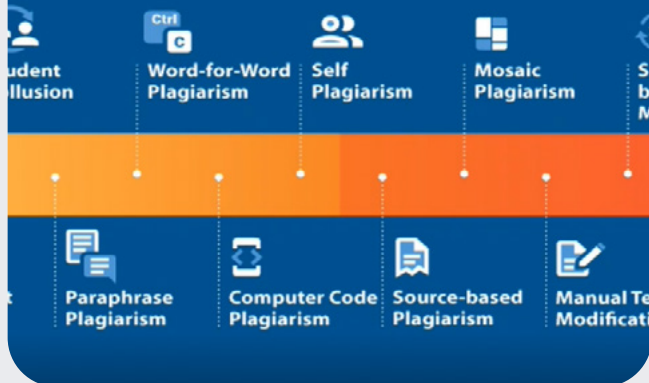
Al Ain University Celebrates “Isra and Miraj” Day

A workshop about academic honesty and avoiding plagiarism

During the workshop, the presenter discussed plagiarism and its impact on academic performance, as well as best practices on how to avoid plagiarism.

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The College of Engineering organizes an event entitled Treasure Hunt

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A Student visit to Abu Dhabi Media City
